James M. Smart (Grandpa) Borned in August 27, 1834, Cole County, Illinois  
Margaret Clapp (Grandma) Borned in February 4, 1844, Edgar County, Illinois  
James Smart married Margaret Clapp February 16, 1866, Edgar County, Illinois  
Then James Smarts moved to Limes Springs, Minnesota. Later they moved to  
Beaver Township, Filmore County, Minnesota. James Smart and family left  
Minnesota, by covered wagon to Pilot Point, Texas. They lived several years  
there. James Smart raised cattle there on the ranch. Jame Smart was laid  
to rest in 1903, Denton, Texas. Grandma Smart and family left Texas, October  
14, 1905, and they took a Homestead place, 160 acres, 6 miles West of Clinton,  
Oklahoma, Custer County, along the Washata River near Stafford, Oklahoma.  
Grandma Smart and her son, and soninlaw, Pete Kenney, and Bill, and George  
drove their cattle from Texas to Clinton, Oklahoma, where they sold the  
cattle there. Bill Smart a son went back to Pilot Point, Texas. Grandma  
and Grover Smart a son farmed the place for serveral years. Grandma Smart  
was laid to rest in December 24, 1909, Port, Oklahoma, Cemetery. George  
J. Smart and Grover Smart farmed the homesteads for many years. George  
Smart had a Public Sale, sold his Farm and Stock, May 1, 1908, he sold  
everything.

First Son

George J. Smart was borned at Limes Springs, Minnesota, May 4, 1875.  
George J. Smart married Lora Vale Edgar Janurary 1, 1905 at Aropohe,  
Oklahoma, had eight childern. Lora V. Edgar was borned June 7, 1885, Ray  
County near Richmond, Missouri. George J. Smart and Bill Smart had a  
grocery store in Texola, Texas, before he was married. Later years George  
Smart and Wife and family moved to Cordell, Oklahoma. After selling the  
Homestead place. George Smart had another grocery store at Cordell,  
Oklahoma, for some years. George Smart and family moved to Cloud Chief,  
Oklahoma, where he and Bill had another grocery store. After serveral years  
George brought a ranch at Brathwaite, Oklahoma, he raied Cotton and  
Wheat. He farmed serveral years there, then moved back to Cordell. We  
We lived there several years. In the Spring of April 1, 1916, we moved  
to the State of Washington, at Colville, Washington. We lived there  
three months, then we moved to Rice, Washington, for three months. George  
worked on a cattle and fruit ranch near Rice, Washington, upon Green  
Mountain a year. We moved to the Spokane Valley out at Green Acres,  
Washington. George rented a five acres fruit ranch. We moved to Green  
Acres, Washington in May 12, 1918, in the Spring. We lived there until  
the fall of 1921, when we moved to Half Moon Parrie, Washington, twenty  
miles North of Spokane, Washington. We farmed 100 Acres and had 140 of  
pasture and timber land. In the Spring of April 1926, we moved to  
Wenatchee, Washington. George brought a fruit ranch up Squilchuck. My  
father George was sick for several years then we laid him to rest  
September 23, 1934, at the age of 59 years old, was buried in Wenatchee  
Cemetery.

First Son

Clifford L. Smart was borned November 27, 1906, on the Homestead near  
Stafford, Oklahoma. He started to school at Cordell, Oklahoma. We moved  
to Washington, I went to school at Kettle Falls, Washington, and Green  
Acres, Washington, and finished up at Half Moon Parrie, Washington. I went  
though the Eight grade. When we moved to Wenatchee, I worked in the Fruit  
orchards. In the fall of November 8, 1935, I took Mother and Sister Helen  
to Madera, Californina. My Mother was very sick.

We came back to Wenatchee for 2 springs and summers, and falls. In the fall of 1937 mother and I stayed in California. I worked on a fruit and Vineyards. In the spring of 1940 I went to work for Montgomery and Wards as warehouse clerk. In the spring of 1941 I went to work for the Forrest Service until October 10. I was drafted into the U.S. Army November 5, 1942. We were shipped by boat, to Honolulu, Oahu, Hawaii. I took my basic training at Schofield Barracks or Red Hill. February 18, 1943 I took two weeks training on 90MM and 105M.M. guns. On March 3, 1943 I was assigned to 714 Gun BN A.A.A. Artillery. Was stationed on the North Shore of Pearl Harbor. We guarded the north shore for Submarines, and enemy destroyers. We were serving in the Pacific. Anarctic Theatre. I never did any soldiering in the States all overseas. December 9, 1944 was shipped to United States, by C 54 plane and C 52 to, Hot Springs Arkansas, Army and Navy Hospital, for treatments for Arthritis. I was Honorable Discharged, March 12 1945 at Hot Springs, Arkansas. I went back to Madera, California for two months. I then left Madera, to Indianapolis, Indiana. I got married June 3, 1945 to Vivian Schoner a widow. I started to work June 20, 1945 for the 2nd Army at Fort Benjamin Harrison, Indiana. Worked there two years then transferred to the Veterans Administration Hospital at Fort Benjamin Harrison there. June the 18, 1950, I transferred to Fresno, California to Veterans Administration Hospital, ~~here~~. I was divorced January of 1957. I worked at the V.A. Hospital until the spring of January 28, 1959. I moved back to Wenatchee, Washington, where I bought a 14½ acres of Cherries. I married Jacqueline F. Newell, June 3, 1961. She was borned in January 7, 1934. *Wenatchee WA* We lived ~~there~~ till the Spring of January 28, 1970. We sold out and bought another cherry ranch of 2 acres at lower Sunnyslope, north of Wenatchee about 5 miles. My mother Lora V. Smart was laid to rest February 4, 1970 at Belmont Cemetery, Fresno, California, she was 79.
